Lynne Ellen Provenzano passed away unexpectedly at her home on Friday, March 20, 2020. She was 65 years old. Lynne was born on January 6, 1955 in Roseville, Michigan to Rudolph "Rudy" Fortunato and Theresa "Terry" Mae (Misiukiewicz) Campeotto.

Lynne graduated from Fraser High School in 1973. She attended the University of Detroit Mercy for two years before graduating from the University of Michigan with a Bachelors of Science in 1977. Lynne married Giacomo "Jack" Provenzano on September 17, 1982.

They had two children together, Dominic Rudolph and Mia Katherine. Over the past several months, Lynne had been very much enjoying her retirement after working as a dental hygienist for over 40 years. Lynne was widely involved in the community spending many years in parent organizations while her children were in school, Junior League, the Michigan State Chapter of P.E.O., St. Mary's hospital and St. Dominic parish.
